SECOND SUNDAY AFTER CHRISTMAS

The Things of My Father

January 4, 2026

AS WE GATHER
What a jump! Only a few days ago we were singing of the Savior’s birth in Bethlehem, and the Gospel for today tells us about Jesus as a youth of twelve years conversing with the teachers in the temple! Mary and Joseph must have been completely confused about Jesus’ desire to stay in the temple, but it was obvious to Him. Jesus manifested the wisdom of the Father in heaven already as a child, the Son of Mary growing and maturing in mortal frame yet manifesting fully the heavenly wisdom of the Son of God. He surpassed the wisdom of Solomon and became the revelation of the Father that brings salvation to all who believe in Him. Jesus needed to be doing the things of His Father and so should we be as well. This, too, is the Christmas story.
