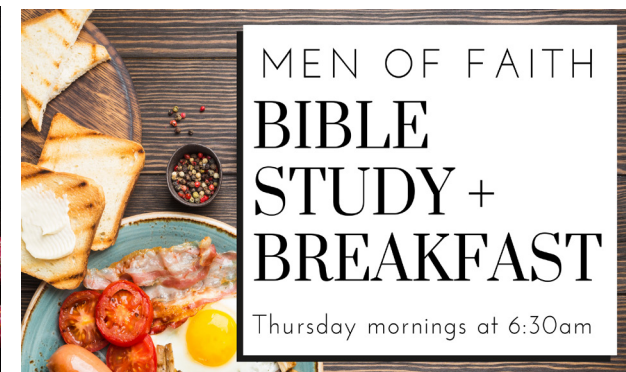

We justly deserve your present and eternal punishment. But we are heartily sorry for our sins and call out to you in repentance. Be gracious to us and hear our prayer for the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Pastor: Almighty God has had mercy on us and provides us righteousness apart from the Law in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ Jesus, the Lamb who once was slain. By the grace of God, we are made clean by the blood of the Lamb. Therefore, as his called and ordained servant of the Church of Christ, I announce the grace of God to all of you, and by his command I declare the entire forgiveness of all your sins, in the name of the Father and of the ✠ Son and of the Holy Spirit.
